



## Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

### Attended Funeral (funeral director's charges only)

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£260.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's Hamish Hoey & Son Ltd, 37 – 39 Stevenson Street, Oban PA34 5NA	£160.00
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from a light oak veneer with wreath holding raised lid and fully furnished	£625.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£60.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£490.00

### Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

<b>Burial (funeral director's charges only)</b>	£2,160.00
<b>Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)<sup>2</sup></b>	£2,610.00

### Fees You Must Pay

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the <b>burial fee</b> . <sup>1</sup>	£992.00

<sup>1</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

We may not know the amount of third party charges in advance of the funeral, however we will give you a best estimate of such charges on the written estimate. The actual amount of the charge will be detailed and shown in the final account.

Our funeral account is due for payment within 30 days from the date of account, unless otherwise agreed by us in writing.

If you fail to pay us in full on the due date, we may charge you interest at the rate of 4% above the bank's base rate. The interest will accrue daily from the due date until the date of payment. You must pay us interest together with any overdue amount. In exceptional circumstances we may employ the services of a debt recovery agency to secure payment on our behalf. You must pay us all reasonable costs, fees, disbursements, and charges (including legal fees) incurred by us in the recovery of any debt.

We may ask you to pay a deposit prior to the funeral taking place.
